Your group will meet with the Red Shirt Ushers prior to the beginning of the concert at 7:00 pm on Eureka Street (In front of Mission Gables House). Concerts are on Tuesday and Friday evenings beginning at 8pm with selected Saturdays. Intermission generally begins at 9:00pm and will take about 15 minutes.
