## ABOUT THE ARTIST

Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1940, Frankie Avalon seized every opportunity, even as a young child, to enter local music competitions, winning one after another. On his own initiative, he began taking music lessons, and continued through the years that followed. Soon he was making guest appearances on The Perry Como and Jackie Gleeson Television Shows.

In 1959 he scored two #1 hits on the Billboard Hot 100, "Venus" and "Why". He had 31 charted U.S. Billboard singles from 1958 to late 1962, including "Just Ask Your Heart" (#7), and "Bobby Sox To Stockings" (#8). His music became one of the defining sounds of "Pre-Beatles" Rock and Roll.

Frankie Avalon's years as a "Teenage Idol" have been succeeded by a long and enduring career as one of the most sought after artists in the world. He is currently one of the busiest nightclub performers in the country, headlining top Las Vegas venues. His motion picture career has spanned some thirty films, including the highly successful "Beach Party" film series, "The Dark," "I'll Take Sweden," and "The Take."
